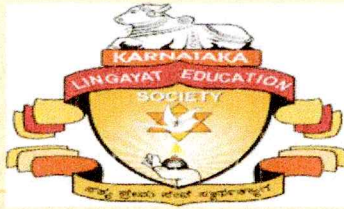

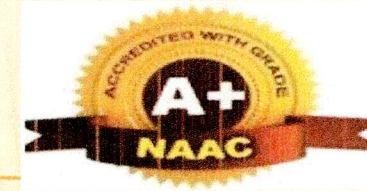

Induction 1: PICK & SPEAK Date – 23/09/2019

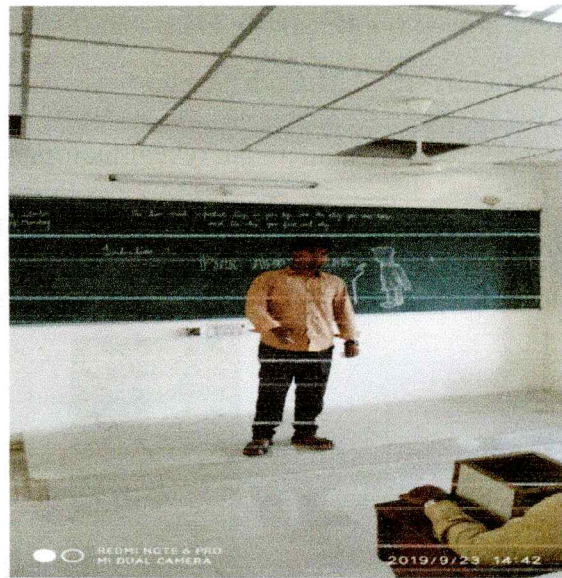
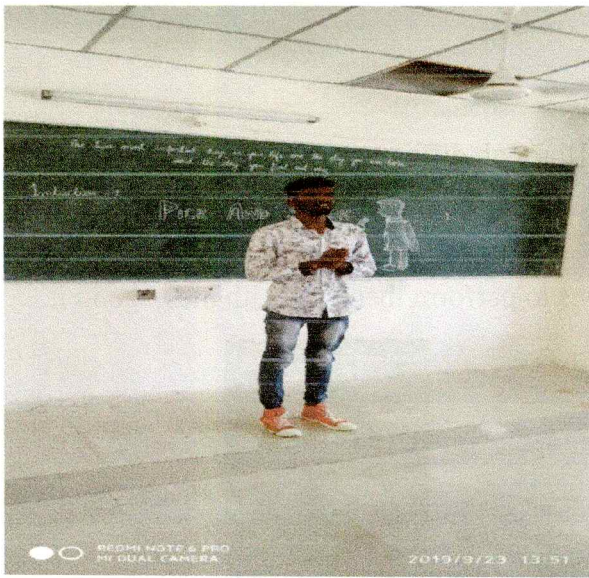

Rules: Each group of students is given 6 minutes to perform their skit with message in it.



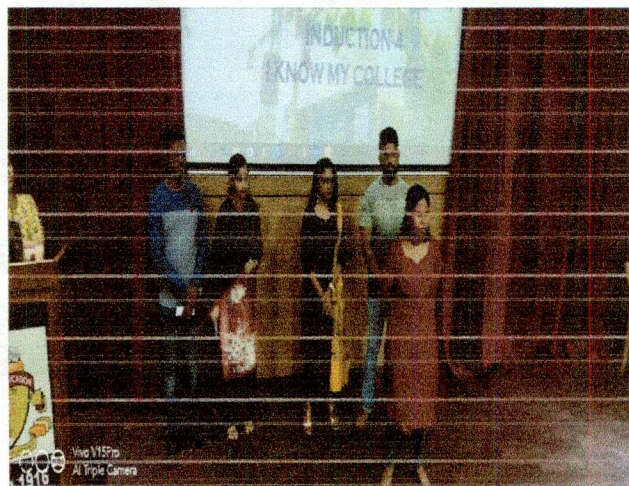

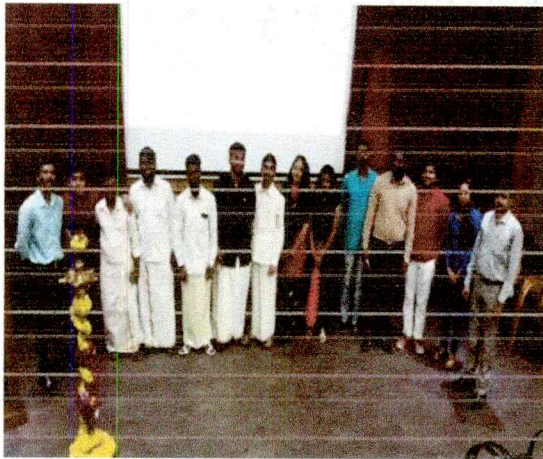
