





Communication/ Listening and started with Resilience.

On the second day where magic bus gave on the how to have proper Communication. Good communication is essential to emotional resilience because it breeds positive emotions instead of negative ones. Knowing more about how to communicate clearly and with sensitivity can help you to avoid problems before they start.

There are multiple postures or attitudes people can take up when communicating with one another. People can take an aggressive and challenging posture towards others, for instance, by making accusations and threats designed to intimidate or compel particular responses. They can

also take a passive posture towards others, for instance, by accepting threats and accusations without challenge. There are serious problems with both of these postures, however, in that they both tend to produce and prolong unnecessary conflicts, and in general to create stress where it doesn't need to exist. Aggressive communication postures convey a lack of respect for those who are threatened, while passive postures convey a lack of self-respect on the part of the person being threatened.

Day 3: Team Building and Resilience

The most successful leaders inspire people, believe in others' potential, and show empathy even when faced with difficult decisions. Most people don't immediately become managers the moment they enter the working world. They start on the bottom rung of the ladder and gradually take on more responsibilities until they reach leadership level.




Where magic bus showed some sample resume and how to create the resume and also preferred which type job role you want apply and also you need to add some for the type job role in the skills in that resume.


